

Tang Shiu Kin Scout And Guide Centre

Notices (with effect from April 1, 2021)

All venue users have to comply with Cap. 599F Prevention and Control of Disease (Requirements and Directions) (Business and Premises) Regulation and Cap. 599G Prevention and Control of Disease (Prohibition on Group Gathering) Regulation on the prohibition of group gatherings of not more than the number of people as stipulated by these Regulations. The Joint Management Committee will adopt special measures at the Centre to avoid people from gathering and to maintain social distance. Venue users must comply with the following special measures until further notice.

1. Perform temperature check at ground floor main entrance before entering the Centre. People with fever symptoms will not be permitted to enter the Centre.
2. The organization is requested to ensure users are not currently subject to any quarantine order issued by the Government. If the users have symptoms of cough, shortness of breath, breathing difficulty and sore throat, please seek medical advice immediately.
3. Wear mask in all areas, during physical activities and use of the venue.
4. Users are required to scan the "LeaveHomeSafe" QR code or register their name, contact number, the date and time of the visit before being allowed to enter. Except users who have submitted "2019 Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Declaration Form for Travel History and Health Status" issued by our Association.
5. According to the summary of the latest measures on scheduled premises to protect the participants, the coaches of sport activity are required to submit the SMS confirming negative test result of polymerase chain reaction (RT-PCR) nucleic acid tests at least one working day (Monday to Friday except public holiday) before the visit (Please email to tskbooking@hkgga.org.hk with the name of organization, activity date and time).
6. To ensure the hygiene of the venue, 30 minutes will be reserved for cleaning before or after the next appointment.
7. Keep your hands clean all the time. Hand rub is provided in the Centre for necessary use.
8. No eating or drinking is allowed inside all venues.
9. If anyone violates the guidelines above, the Association reserves the right to request that person to leave the venue.
10. Visitors may be required to leave except he/she enters the venue to perform official duty or has booked for the use of Centre venues, other people are not suggested to stay in the Centre in order to minimize the risk of spread of virus during gathering of people.

Cleaning arrangement in Tang Shiu Kin Scout and Guide Centre :

To minimize the risk of contracting and spreading COVID-19, cleaning arrangements are enhanced to safeguard the health of users at the Centre :

- After every use of venue, tables / chairs / floor will be disinfected with 1 in 49 diluted household bleach.
- Public facilities (e.g. lift, lobby, corridor) will be disinfected with 1 in 49 diluted household bleach daily.
- Frequently contacted surfaces (e.g. button, handrail, door handle, door knob, doorbell, power switch) will be disinfected with 1 in 49 diluted household bleach daily.
- For obvious dirt, cleaning will be done immediately.
- All visitors entering the Centre are required to check body temperature, to wear a mask and to clean their hands with disinfectant to help preventing spread of the disease.
- Except venue users and event participants, other people are suggested not to stay in the Centre in order to lower the risk of spread of virus during gathering of people.

Toilet Hygiene

- Toilet will be disinfected with 1 in 49 diluted household bleach every four hours.
- Soap will be provided for hand cleaning.
- Users are reminded to put the toilet lid down before flushing and clean and wash hands properly after using the toilet.
- Maintain drainage pipes properly by pouring about half a litre of water into each drain outlet (U-traps) every week.
