# Introduction to Leadership Champion

"To be the leading international youth organisation in Hong Kong for the personal development and leadership training for girls and young women."

> — Organisational Vision of The Hong Kong Girl Guides Association

The Hong Kong Girl Guides Association (HKGGA) has continued to develop and grow girls and young women through the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts' (WAGGGS) unique non-formal educational method. We truly believe that through empowering girls and young women and unleashing their potential allows them to become the future leaders of our society.

With its 105th Anniversary approaching, HKGGA launched this programme hoping to train our girls and young women to become not only leaders, but also become champions who have successfully challenged and exceeded themselves. We hope to build a sustainable leadership style, where our Leadership Champions impact their community and those around them.



## Programme Overview

The **Leadership Champion** programme consists of 3 stages, where girls and young women will learn at their own pace.

There are different learning objectives, goals and tasks for each stage:

#### **Stage 1: Leadership Learner**


- You learn about the 6 Leadership Mindsets through activities and workshops organised by HKGGA and within Units.
- You must complete or attend at least 1 activity or workshop in every mindset, meaning you should have completed or attended at least 6 activities or workshops by the end of this stage. There is no required order in completing the Leadership Mindset activities or workshops. Upon completion, you will earn the title of Leadership Learner and receive the corresponding pin. You will then be eligible for Stage 2: Leadership Practitioner.



## Programme Overview

#### **Stage 2: Leadership Practitioner**

- You practise the 6 Leadership Mindsets through HKGGAorganised, large-scale events.
- You are required to complete the **Leadership Practitioner** Reflection Log after joining the large-scale event.
- You must complete Leadership Practitioner before proceeding to Leadership Master. Upon completion of this stage, participants will earn the title of Leadership Practitioner and receive the corresponding pin.



## Programme Overview

#### **Stage 3: Leadership Masters**

- By this stage, you are familiar with the 6 Leadership Mindsets, and are ready to contribute back to the community.
- You need to select a social issue or topic that they are passionate about, and plan a community project that advocates, serves or alleviates the selected social issue.
- Training or workshops may be organised by HKGGA during this stage to support your community project planning.
- You are required to submit a community project plan or proposal.
- You are required to complete the **Leadership Master** Reflection Log after submitting your community project plan.
- You attend a final presentation on the community projects to share your plan and implementation details (if any), deliverables, community impacts achieved, , and how the 6 Leadership Mindsets were contextualised.
- You may form groups and work on the same proposal in this stage. There are no requirements or limitations to group formation. If you have implemented your community project, the service hours and other relevant work completed in this stage may also be used to fulfill requirements of other HKGGA programmes and badge assessments.
- Upon completion of Leadership Practitioner, you will earn the title of a **Leadership Master** and receive the corresponding pin. Outstanding performers of the final presentation will earn the title Leadership Champion.

There will be an award ceremony for outstanding performers of the final presentation. Further details about the arrangement will be announced in due course.

# Introduction to the WAGGGS Leadership Model

In 2018, WAGGGS published the WAGGGS Leadership Model Summary, where WAGGGS worked with the University of Exeter to design a new leadership model for girls and young women's leadership journeys. This report lays out the 6 Leadership Mindsets that outline the important qualities of a global leader, and serves as a tool to allow us to be more aware of our leadership practices. Leadership is no longer just about skill sets, but also about understanding your own values, perspectives and behaviours.

#### The WAGGGS Leadership Model includes the following 6 Leadership Mindsets:

- Collaborative Mindset
- Creative & Critical Thinking Mindset
- Responsible Action Mindset
- Gender Equality Mindset
- Worldly Mindset
- Reflective Mindset

The 6 Leadership Mindsets will be continuously explored and reinforced throughout your **Leadership Champion** journey.
