Fire Prevention

- I. Understand the theory of burning.
- II. Explain the different causes of fires.
- III. List fire crises and the way of reporting it.
- IV. Know how to call for the Fire Service in case of fire.
- V. Illustrate how to prevent fires at home, at school and at a Girl Guides Campsite.
- VI. Describe the causes of fires in outdoor activities, how to prevent fires such as vegetation fires, camp fires, outdoor cooking, etc.
- VII. The procedure taken and the evacuation of people in case of a fire.
- VIII. Know the kinds of fire extinguishers and their uses and use a diagram to show the different kinds of fire prevention facilities at your home building or school.
- IX. Know the different kinds of fire hydrant.
- X. List the types of dangerous goods and their labels.
- XI. Introduce the work of the Hong Kong Fire Services.
- XII. Introduce grading of fires and their types.
- XIII. Introduce the types of fire engines and fire boats.
- XIV. Visit a fire station and use a diagram to show the location of fire stations near your home and school. (Visiting of fire station must be arranged by HGGGA or the Sponsoring Authorities of the Unit.)
- XV. Introduce fire prevention activities in Hong Kong such as Fire Safety Ambassadors, Building Safety Ambassadors and open days, etc.
- XVI. Explain and demonstrate the following:
 1. Transportation of a casualty
 2. Treatment of burns

Note

Girl Guides who are Fire Safety Ambassadors will be exempted from Clauses I to IV, VII, X and XI when presenting the Fire Safety Ambassador Certificate during assessment.

Remarks

An appointed Guider who holds a valid Fire Prevention Instructor Certificate may take this badge assessment for her own Unit.
