Go Green

- I. Explain to the Assessor what “Ecology” is and elaborate the relationship between different elements such as different living things or living things and non-living things.
- II. Use a diagram to elaborate the food chain.
- III. Provide a definition of wetlands and introduce the wetland in Hong Kong. Give examples of species of wetland organisms including various kinds of plants, birds, etc. and their adaptive features for the wetland environment.
- IV. List the Country Code and the code of visiting a wetland.
- V. Visit one of the following places, record your observation, share your experiences with the Assessor and elaborate the role that this place plays in conservation.
 1. A wetland or wetland park
 2. A country park or marine park
- VI. Choose one from the following:
 1. Make a model of not less than 8” x 8” x 4” with recycled or reused material to demonstrate the functions of wetland.
 2. Make a model of a water filter to demonstrate the filtering of water.
 3. Show how to save water in daily life by using graphic art or an animation.
