4.	<i>Airport Authority Hong Kong (AAHK)</i> The Integrated Airport Centre (IAC) is the nerve centre of HKIA's operations. It is now one of the world's largest integrated airport operation and management centres at more than 5,760 sqm. With over 160 console workstations, a larger number of colleagues from different positions in the airport community, including airlines, aircraft servicing, terminal operations, aviation security, land and sea transport can work under one roof for closer communication and more efficient execution of commands. A wrap-around LED video wall in the main hall shows real-time operational information, coupled with an artificial intelligence system that monitors more than 30 key performance indicators to assure the smooth running of HKIA around the clock.
