Campsites Notice (with effect from 19 October 2020)

As the COVID-19 pandemic has stabilized and pursuant to the announcement by the government in lifting certain social distancing measures, Leung Sing Tak Sea Activities Training Centre has been reopened on 9 September 2020 and the rest of the campsites will be reopened on 19 October 2020.

All venue users have to comply with the Prevention and Control of Disease (Prohibition on Group Gathering) Regulation (Cap. 599G) on the prohibition of group gatherings of more than the number of people as stipulated by the law. The Association will adopt special measures at the campsite to avoid people from gathering and to minimize social contact. Venue users must comply with the following special measures until further notice:

1. Wear mask in all campsites areas except during physical activities or inside the dormitory/family unit.
2. Perform temperature check at the front gate before entering the campsites. People with fever symptoms will not be permitted to enter the campsites.
3. For the residential camp, temperature check of campers everyday are required. If a camper has fever, please inform the campsite's staff immediately. If there are more than 1 camper with fever symptom, the campsite's staff will inform the Headquarters management immediately. To keep the campers and staff members' healthy and safe, we might close the campsite immediately to conduct thoroughly cleaning and disinfection.
4. Keep your hands clean all the time. Hand rub is provided in the campsites for necessary use.
5. Maximum capacity of the campsites will be adjusted as follows:

6. Only **ONE organization** will be served each time.
7. **The maximum capacity of every dormitory should not be more than 4 people.**

* No more than FOUR participants including the instructor in a cluster could be conducted, with appropriate 1.5 meters distance maintained between groups.

9. Only alternate shower cubicles can be used to keep social distancing between users. (except family unit and twin-bed room).
10. Toilet and changing room will be cleaned and disinfected every 4 hours (except family unit and twin-bed room).
11. Alternate table / special set-up are required for the dining venue.
 - Tables are separated by at least 1.5 meters.
 - Maximum capacity for each table is 4 people.
12. No eating or drinking is allowed inside all facilities and venues except dining venue
13. Barbecue pits will remain suspended.
14. Other Special Arrangement
 - Pok Hong Campsite
 - Hiring of camping equipment will be suspended.
 - Jockey Club Beas River Lodge
 - Catering service will be arranged by meal box ordering only (liaising with contractor)
15. If anyone violates the guidelines above, the Association reserves the right to request that person to leave the venue.
16. Although epidemic situation continues to ease, the government is still implementing disease prevention and control measures to safeguard public health. In this connection, any Girl Guides members who are intending to conduct Girl Guides' programmes or activities in campsites should refer to the latest respective guidelines published on the website of the Hong Kong Girl Guides Association
