

## **Progression in Training**

The HKGGA Training Scheme for Leaders aims to develop outstanding leaders who enable girls in their units to become community leaders and global citizens.

Guiding is a means of developing caring leaders and responsible citizens. It is delivered as 'girls learning by doing' in an enjoyable fun filled way.

The updated Training Scheme for Leaders is a 5-level progressive orderly scheme that uses 'learning by doing' with leaders so they can use this method with their girls. It has a diverse list of skills, knowledge and abilities that Leaders should acquire so that they can nurture girls to achieve their full potential as Global Citizens.

Level 1 gives you, the Leader, the basic knowledge of Guiding and Method of delivery to start your journey forward as a passionate leader. As you progress through the next 4 levels, you will develop a deeper understanding of Guiding Knowledge, Skills and abilities will empower you to enable your girls to reach their fullest potential as future community leaders and global citizens.

The longer you stay, the more qualified you become. 'Once a Guide, always a Guide'.

Your progress is documented in the Leader Training Scheme Record Book. This will assist you to record the progressive levels in Training and the new challenges you need to give the maximum opportunity for you to develop leadership of and for women.



## **Badge Issuance Guidelines**

1. When a leader has completed the Leader Training Course, she will be given a Leader Training Scheme Record Book and one Leader Training Recognition Badge (Red). As the leader completes each of the further stages, she will be awarded the appropriate Recognition Badge.

- 2. Before a leader purchases each bar badge, she must bring the Leader Training Scheme Record Book and supporting documents to the Training Section of Hong Kong Girl Guides Association for verification and signature.
- 3. The Surplus training hours cannot be transferred to the badge of the next level as they fulfill subject matter requirement for the current level.
